

Lean Curriculum - 2017

LEANwRIGHT Introduction to Lean – ½ day or 4 hours

Prerequisite(s): None

Class Size: Up to 30 depending on classroom or venue size

Description: This class covers what is Lean, Waste, Kaizen and it highlights the most common lean tools. The class includes a 75 minute office or LEGO® manufacturing simulation depending on the client's needs and preferences.

Cost: \$1,500-\$2,500 plus expenses per class depending on training location

LEANwRIGHT Lean 101 – 2 full days or four ½ days or 16 hours

Prerequisite(s): None

Class Size: Up to 24 depending on classroom or venue size

Description: This class covers Lean in detail with multiple exercises, videos and in-depth coverage of all of major the Lean Tools. The class includes a 75 minute office or LEGO® manufacturing simulation depending on the client's needs and preferences. A twenty-five question exam must be passed to receive a LEANwRIGHT Lean 101 certificate of completion.

Cost: \$4,800-\$9,600 plus expenses per class depending on training location and number of visits required to complete the training

TRAINING



LEANwRIGHT Lean Certification – 4 full days or 32 hours plus project time

Prerequisite(s): None

Class Size: Up to 24 depending on classroom or venue size

Description: This class covers Lean in detail with numerous hands-on exercises, videos and in-depth coverage of all of major the Lean Tools. The class includes several team exercises and Office and Manufacturing simulations. Each student receives a binder with all learning materials. Students must identify, plan and execute a Kaizen Blitz event or equivalent Lean project in addition to passing a fifty question exam to receive their LEANwRIGHT Lean Certification. Projects must be completed typically within 3 months of the class.

Cost: \$1,500-\$2,000 per student plus expenses depending on training location and number of visits required to complete the training and project reviews

LEANwRIGHT Kaizen Blitz Facilitator Certification – varies by student

Prerequisite(s): Lean 101 or Lean Certification

Class Size: Up to 12 Protégés

Description: This training is based on Kaizen Blitz event ideation, planning and execution. Students must have a venue (their company or organization) to develop and complete their Kaizen Blitz events. Coaching and development is completed during the actual Kaizen Blitz events. Initial events may require co-facilitation with the trainer as may subsequent events depending on the student's capabilities. Certification is based on successful completion of at least 2 but no more than 4 events.

Cost: \$2,500-\$3,600 per student plus expenses depending on event location and number of visits required to complete the certification
