After the service, we had dinner on the grounds and had a Q & A session. One week, Ginger and I did the children's church, and the last Sunday we were there, I preached a message on missions; closing out their missions month, followed by a wonderful dinner on the grounds that all the ladies prepared. One of our other goals when we come to a church is to be try to be an encouragement, a blessing and to help where help is needed. One Saturday the church had a work day. We helped move furniture and clean out areas that had been used for storage. One room we cleaned out in order to make a nursery. Miss Leah and Ginger put Kiltz on the walls and a man in the church sprayed on the paint. Curtains were put up, furniture moved in and a nursery was born! Ginger also helped Miss Leah organize all the Sunday School curriculum and the Sunday school room. The last project we helped with before leaving was decking the roof.
