Ordinance O-2013-47

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE O-2013-46, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH WAYNE SIMPSON DBA SIMPSON CONSTRUCTION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS ALONG AMELIA OLIVE BRANCH ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, On October 8, 2013, Council adopted Ordinance O-2013-46, authorizing the Mayor and Fiscal Officer to enter into a contract for the construction of sidewalks along Amelia Olive Branch Road, but the ordinance permitted the contract with Simpson Construction, which is not a legal entity.

WHEREAS, The construction of the Kroger Marketplace store has enabled Village residents to walk to the store, but several streets in the vicinity of the store do not have sidewalks, making it hazardous for citizens to walk to the store; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that walkable communities are thriving, livable, sustainable places that give their residents safe transportation choices and improved quality of life; and

WHEREAS, Wayne Simpson dba Simpson Construction has submitted a proposal to construct additional sidewalks along Amelia Olive Branch Road adjacent to Clermont County Auditor's Parcels 050118.035, 034928.001A, 034928.002A, 0344928.003A, and 034551D021.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Ohio, that:

SECTION I That Ordinance O-2013-46 is hereby repealed due to an error in the contracting entity's title.

SECTION II Village Council has reviewed the proposal from Wayne Simpson dba Simpson Construction to perform the necessary sidewalk construction in the amount of twenty two thousand two hundred dollars and zero cents (\$22,200.00).

SECTION III Village Council hereby directs the Mayor and Fiscal Officer to enter into the sidewalk construction proposal on behalf of the Village, substantially in the form of attached Exhibit A.

SECTION IV Village Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION V This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary to approve this agreement immediately, in order to improve pedestrian safety for the citizens of Amelia Village. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

DERRICK CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.

RENÉE GERBER seconded the motion for adoption of the ordinance.




