Crane Hammond: Age 30 – 50. An author. Charming, bright, gay, witty, an altogether likeable person.

Kate Bixley: Age 30 - 50. Crane's secretary, irrepressible sense of humor that often borders on the sarcastic. She and Crane are good friends.

Jenny: Age 18 – 25. Young country girl, the epitome of innocence, less than helpful maid of the rental cottage.

Lillian Seymour: Aged 30 – 50. Top-flight fashion designer and friend of Crane.

Helen O'Toole: Age 30 – 50. Efficient real estate saleswoman, a trifle too folksy and strait-laced at times.

Vernon Cookley: Age 40 - 60. Taxi driver, sheriff, dog catcher, Justice of the Peace, sexton of the Church. New Englander, not well traveled, understated.

Randolph: Age 30 – 40. Cheap crook/hoodlum. Wants to make a name for himself in the criminal world.

Lyle Rogers: Age 30 – 50. Lillian's new second husband, a charming, affable man.

Philip Smith: Age 30 – 40. Amnesiac trying to recall why he is at the cottage, assumed to be criminal.

Richard Hammond: Age 30 - 50. Crane's husband, also a writer, caught in the madness due to his late arrival.
