Here are some suggestions we as Catholics could do to prepare :

- 1- Make an Advent wreath. The wreath is a circle, which has no beginning or end: God is eternal, and His love for us is everlasting. This daily practice will help each member of the family keep focused on the true meaning of Christmas.
- 2- Pray. Hopefully prayer already is part of the daily routine, but if not, this is a good time to make it one.
- 3- Third, read Scripture.
- 4- Take the time for confession. Do a thorough examination of conscience.
- 5- Preach, this can be as easy as saying, "Merry Christmas," not "Happy holidays" or "Seasons greetings".
- 6- Put up your manger, like the Advent wreath, keep it as a focal point throughout the season.
- 7- Give. Give of yourself by doing good works. We as Order of the Alhambra members already give of our time very freely, but there is quite often room to do more.
- 8- Church. Go to mass regularly.

Prepare for this Advent as though Christ were coming for the first time. Make this Christmas a celebration of the birth of Our Savior and the great gift of faith we have received.
