#### IHCC Chapter 5 - General Member Meeting April 2, 2022 - Vinton, Iowa

Meeting called to order by President Bob Gihring at 1:00 PM, he welcomed everyone followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Introduction of board members, recognized any new members, scholarship winners and guests. Introduced Karen Franks, our new treasurer, and a couple friends Troy Mills, Jack and Byron Bock.

Minutes from previous meeting were read by secretary Paul Schaefer, motion to approve by Calvin Mennenga and Bob Anderlick, motion passed.

Treasurers Report: Karen Franks and Calvin Mennenga, in transition to move Karen as Treasurer. As of March 31, 2022 beginning checkbook balance: \$21,910.39. Income: Interest \$4.44, Membership \$455.00, Merchandise \$738.50, Total March checking income: \$1,197.94, Sub balance \$23,108.33.

Expenses: beginning checkbook balance transfer in \$2,500.00. Newsletter printing and postage: \$825.90, Bradford checks \$40.94, Capital letters square card reader \$10.69. Sub-Total \$877.53. Ending checkbook balance \$1,622.47.

Ending checkbook balance: \$23,108.33, outstanding checks \$500.00, statement balance \$23,608.33.

Restricted funds \$102,854.15, unrestricted funds \$4,254.18, CD matures 1/31/2023 \$85,000.00 at 0.83%. Checkbook balance \$23,108.33. Total Monies \$108,108.33.

Newsletter-Website - Pam: so far this year 2,900 hits on website, last year 18,000, with an average of 20,157 hits. Of the 408 members I have 290 with email addresses. Deadline for newsletter July 8<sup>th</sup>.

Merchandise - Bob: \$170-\$180 in sales at January meeting, new orders of youth shirts, and "mom and dad" shirts. Any other ideas for merchandise see a board member.

Scholarship - Linelle: Last of transcripts received awards sent out. Five applications have been received for this year. May have been an email issue, extend deadline until April 15<sup>th</sup>. A motion to extend the deadline to April 15<sup>th</sup> made by Bobbie Hammer, second by Alex Eldred, Motion passed.

Membership - Karen: Currently 407 members of which 194 have paid, three new members, Blake Owen of Grinnell, Curtis Sachau of Charter Oak, and Shawn Harvey of Nevada. Six Harvester Highlights went back to National A/C of Bad address, these are not forwarded out again. Please make sure your address is up to date.

4-H Grants - Bob: Ray was absent, but told Bob he is stepping down from the Grant Program, asked Paul, He will take over program.

National Board - Gary Spina: The Winter Convention was canceled due to the hotel overbooking the venue. There were 224 registered members from 20 states who were planning on coming, the Tennessee Chapter decided to pull out and cancel. Harvester Highlights spring issue should be in mail April 6-8, the regular schedule were working toward is January 1, April 1, July 1, and October 1. Bill Swope was appointed to the National Trust Board. Winter Convention 2023 will be in Roanoke Virginia, RPRU 2025, Missouri has permission from the Board to proceed with information for 2025. Board elections, Joe is stepping down, two other current members going to run again. Joe's seat is open. Bob Gihring is considering a run for National Board.


