Growing national concern about lead poisoning in children has prompted a California lawmaker to introduce legislation to ensure that all the states kids are tested for the toxic metal.

The bill, introduced by Assemblyman Bill Quirk (D-Hayward), would change the state's Health and Safety Code to require testing of all children ages 6 months to 6 years.
