What a beautiful Christmas season we have celebrated this year! The New Year is already here and along with our New Year Resolutions, it is time to think about pledges. As we have done every year, pledge cards will be distributed throughout the parish, and we ask you to prayerfully consider filling one out and returning it in the offering plate. We use pledge cards to help us set our budget for the year. Do not worry! Your pledge will be kept secret, and we will not harass you if you fail to keep your pledge. We encourage you to pledge because, again, it helps us with our budget, and it is a good spiritual "discipline." It is a "discipline" because God expects us to tithe, and sometimes it is hard to get into the habit of giving weekly or monthly. In the Old Testament God required a tithe of ten percent of everything from the Israelites. Ten percent of the best "first fruits" was to be brought into the Temple and presented for the Lord and for His use, Today we are taught to continue this practice, holding a ten percent tithe as the Biblical gold-standard.

But we must remember that pledging is not just about our tithes or treasure but includes our time and talent too. Perhaps you have heard of the three T's before; "time, talent, and treasure." "Time, talent, and treasure" are three valuables everyone has regardless of how rich or poor. After all, it's not just about money! The Mass reminds us of this, during which we present three things to God: our tithes and offerings (our money), the oblation (the bread and wine for Holy Communion), and "ourselves, our souls, and bodies." Do you realize that if we tithe ten percent of the 24 hours in a day, we would spend two hours and forty minutes a day in prayer or service to God? That would be nearly 17 hours a week we could devote to prayer, Bible reading, meditation, attending or serving at Mass, and volunteering to help at charities. And what of our talents? We can use our talents for cooking and baking for parish hospitality, or cooking meals for those in need. Musical talent is easily used for God's glory in the Church, as is talent for networking, business, gardening, decorating, and crafts.

Time, Talent, and Treasure, I challenge you to pledge these three things, these areas of your lives this year. The Mass reminds us, that we are not just to put money in the plate, but to "offer and present...ourselves, our souls, and bodies, to be a holy, reasonable, and living sacrifice" unto God. God wants all of us, He wants us to pledge ourselves, our lives. This year, look at your pledge not as a marker of how much money you are making, but as symbolic of yourself, your time, and your talent.
