Meinard F. Guza, age 93, of Bad Axe, was born into eternal life on Sunday, April 11, 2021, the feast of Divine Mercy. Meinard passed from this life peacefully in his sleep at home with his wife Georgeana by his side and his children praying beside him. Born on September 19, 1927, in Hamtramck, Michigan, Meinard was the second child of six born to the late Edmund and Elizabeth (Swartz) Guza. He married Georgeana Paionk on February 13, 1954, in Warren, Michigan. Meinard was a man of profound faith. He trusted God to provide for his 12 children. And

he exemplified to his family the importance of putting God first. He was a hardworking farmer, although he did have other occupations, and he humbly and jokingly referred to himself as "a jack of all trades but master of none." Meinard was honored to serve his country during the Korean War and remained grateful for the experiences it afforded him. Over the years he was involved in politics and was a fervent advocate for pro-life. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus and served as Grand Knight. Meinard had a wonderful sense of humor which will be sorely missed by those who knew him, and perhaps even greater was his sense of warmth and hospitality toward others.
