- Submit your completed entry form with your check for the entry fee by February 27, 2017 to: CBAC, P.O. Box 25, Washburn, WI 54891.
- This show is open to the general public over the age of 16. Artists may submit up to 2 pieces of original artwork. Artwork previously shown in any CBAC exhibit is not eligible.
- 2-dimensional artwork must be dry, framed, and ready to hang, with screw eyes and wires to correspond with the weight of the artwork. Sawtooth string hangers or extremely fragile work will not be accepted.
- 3-dimensional artwork, such as sculpture, jewelry, ceramics, or carvings, must be stable for pedestals or shelf installation. Jewelers please bring displays for pieces, which will be displayed in locked cases. For large or unusual entries, the artist must provide appropriate display units.
- Please deliver artwork to the Washburn Cultural Center (1 E. Bayfield St., Washburn) on February 28 between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. Pick up artwork on March 30, after the reception (7 p.m.).
- Please plan to attend the public reception, awards ceremony, and closing to the show on Thursday, March 30, from 5 to 7 p.m. at the Washburn Cultural Center.
