



Announcement of FY 2019 CoC Program Project Rankings, FL 505

September 10, 2019

Notification of competition, renewal, application and deadlines were made public to our community via our website, social media, and with email notifications on July 22, 2019.

One renewal project application was submitted by Catholic Charities of NWFL for Permanent Supportive Housing for \$551,335.

One new PSH project was submitted by Catholic Charities of NWFL to expand PSH through the bonus process for \$59,476.

One renewal HMIS project was submitted by HHA (HMIS Lead) \$52,552. The Local RFP states HMIS will always be ranked #1.

One new application was submitted by Homelessness & Housing Alliance for Rapid-Rehousing using the unapplied for amount of \$54,529, the CoC Bonus of \$32,921, and a reallocation from PSH of \$69,672 for a total of \$157,122.

One DV Bonus Rapid Rehousing project was submitted by HHA for \$51,976.

All project applications were scored according to the Scoring Processes, Scoring Tools, and Ranking Procedures publicly noticed with the Request for Proposal and remain on the website and sent via email. The Scoring Tool for Renewal Projects stated that if certain points were not achieved, reallocation should be considered.

Below is the ranking of projects approved for inclusion in the HUD CoC Competition NOFA for FY19.

The following projects will be included on the CoC Priority Listing. Below are the 2019 final ranking and funding amounts:

HUD uses a Tier 1 and Tier 2 funding process. HUD establishes Tier amounts based on the Annual Renewal Demand. FL-505's total ARD is \$658,416. Tier 1 is 94% of the ARD (94% of ARD=\$618,911). Tier 2 is the difference between Tier 1 and the ARD plus bonus project, not including DV Bonus (\$72,426).

HHA is submitting a CoC Planning Project for \$19,752. The CoC Planning Project is not part of the rank and review process.

The total amount FL-505 will be submitting to HUD for FY19 is \$763,065 and includes all projects in Tier 1 and 2, CoC Bonus, DV Bonus, and CoC Planning Project.

Projects not included in the submission to HUD:

Catholic Charities PSH Bonus scored 91/100. The project does not meet community needs. There is no reason to expand the PSH program at this time. This PSH project was unable to meet its goals for the past year. It was determined that Rapid-Rehousing is needed to meet the needs of the community. The Grant Review Committee rejected this project, although it scored well.

The CoC Board of Directors reviewed the Grant Review Committee's recommendations on September 10, 2019. The BOD approved the recommendations and ranking of projects. On September 10, 2019 HHA posted the rankings to the website. All applicants were notified of their acceptance or rejection in writing outside of ESNAPS on September 11, 2019. The notice included their score, project ranking if accepted, and reasons for rejection if applicable.

Ranking these projects was a difficult process and we appreciate the amount of time and effort invested by the applicants to ensure that the Continuum of Care continues to address HUD's funding priorities while meeting the needs of the community.
