
## THE UNFINISHED PASSOVER THE COMPLETION OF THE MARRIAGE SUPPER OF THE LAMB

This illustration shows the crossing over into the Promised Land through the Jordon River at Passover could be a type of the Rapture; at a Passover timing. The Rapture of the Church could occur at a similar timing as a type and shadow of the LORD's Supper that occurred on the eve of the Passover or time of Resurrection, either 1) on an 'eve' of a certain future Passover at a Midnight Hour or 2) at the time of death to correspond with the Resurrection per Romans 6v4. This LORD's Supper was the 'Marital Contract' w/Disciples as Christ then departed at Midnight for the Garden of Gethsemane. Before the departure to the Garden and Cross, Christ promised to return to finish the Meal -but in the Kingdom; this presupposes the Rapture then. This 'going out' and 'going in' perhaps is a clue to the Rapture sequence in such a way as to mirror the timing of when the Israelites crossed into the Promised Land. At time, the Passover occurred and thereafter the Manna stopped. The Book of Joshua 5:11 states that the Manna stopped on the 3rd day after Israel entered the Promised Land. This occurred on the day after Israel celebrated the Passover for the 1st time in the since the Exodus. The illustration also shows the Passover week that transpired. The timeline presents an alternative count from the erroneous 'Good Friday' crucifixion. The timeline also suggests a midnight Blood Moon event.



The timeline of the Passion Week will present an alternative view of the timing of the historical sequence of the Crucifixion. The Days are believed to be complete 12 hour day to night counts. The traditional understanding of the "Sabbath' has contributed to a misunderstanding of when the LROD actually was crucified, buried and risen. The timeline stipulates that the Crucifixion was on a Wednesday, making the Resurrection on the weekly Sabbath afternoon. Romans 6v4 does state that, as Christ was Resurrected, in like manner those in Christ would in the same manner be Resurrected; perhaps same hour.

Perhaps the LORD's Supper, that was celebrated with the Disciples on the eve of the Passover, has yet to be completed at such a similar date & time in the future that might correspond to the RAPTURE on

The Marriage Supper of the Lamb could actually be this conclusion of the LORD's Supper in which the LORD Himself will complete the ceremony of the 4th Cup of Completion in Glory. The LORD's Supper on the Preparation Day can be seen as the 'start' of the Marriage Supper of the Lamb'. This consummation will not be completed until the Bride is called out of this world-as promised by the LORD Himself as portrayed in Revelation

The Elements of the Church Age, of Bread and Wine are reminiscent of the Manna that Israel had throughout the wilderness journey. The Church, the Bride of Christ has been observing this for the past 1980 plus years now. Like the Manna that stopped, the Church will be Raptured out of the world's wilderness and into the Promised Land

It will be like when the Israelites were taken out of Egypt and into the Promised Land by way of supernatural doors, i.e. crossing water barriers impossible for men to have done. Perhaps the types and shadows from Israel's Exodus and the Manna stopping is how the LORD will deal with the evacuation and calling of the Bride to complete the LORD's Supper and Marital Contract.

The cessation of the Manna for Israel occurred after the 1st celebration of Passover in the Promised Land. There after the Battle of Jericho ensued for 6 more days for a total of 7 days. This is prophetic is that the LORD and His Disciples departed the Supper around Midnight for the ne to pray and do 'battle' against Satan's stronghold of this world's 'Jericho'. Perhaps this is the very Rapture timing of

when the LORD will come back with His Disciples to complete the 4th Cup of Completion that was started with the Supper in the Upper Room. to coincided with this time being the 3rd Day, a Tuesday and at Midnight. This time sequence would have coincided with the Manna being stopped for Israel on the eve of the Battle of Jericho, just as Joshua, a type of Jesus went out to do battle against the stronghold of Jericho. Perhaps the Rapture will

coincide with a similar time sequence when the Elements of the Church Age of the Bread and Wine will cease because the Church will be take out, having 'crossed' over into Glory led by Jesus, as Joshua led the Israelites during a Passover season and will partake of the 'grain' of Glory in Heaven for 7 prophetic days and return with Christ thereafter for the Battle of Armageddon. Interestingly, after Israel entered the Promised Land & the Passover was celebrated, the 'judgment' or Sudden Destruction of Jericho followed. This will also happen after the Rapture when the world, a type of Jericho will be taken down



The Manna stopped at or immediately after the 1st Passo once Israel entered the Promised Land. Perhaps likewise, the LORD's Supper that occurred before the Passover is when the Church Age will stop. This window of time is thus when the Rapture could take place if the prophetic parallels
