<u>Seneschal's Report:</u> Lady Xanthippe reported that insurance has been taken care of for 2017 for Gnome Games. Reminder of open officer positions that will be voted on in January-Rapier Marshal, Chronicler, Herald.

MOAS Report: Lady Nimeau reported members are doing lots of fun things. She is working on full size loom plans for a class sometime in 2017.
