WELCOME

Relative to the fact that we will soon welcome new members into the fellowship of St. John's, I'm also thinking about guests and visitors who come to our church. Welcoming new people into our faith family is part of our calling. "Go and make disciples...," Jesus said; our hymns and songs say "I love to tell the story, for some have never heard..." and "You spread His love to everyone, you want to pass it on." However you say it or sing it, this is our task: evangelism!

I know it is easier for some than others to offer a word of welcome to a stranger. Some of you are more outgoing and are more comfortable striking up a conversation with a newcomer, visitor, or guest. But it's vital! I was recently told by some regular visitors that nobody has approached them to offer a word of welcome. We have an important function as church members to extend a hand and say the welcoming word.

It's not just the pastor's job. You actually have more time after church to talk. I try to briefly greet as many as possible as they leave the Sanctuary. That takes time. You have the opportunity for real ministry by approaching someone you don't know, introducing yourself, asking their name, and welcoming them.

As a way of helping you I'm including the following borrowed article (source unknown)...

"WHAT DO YOU SAY TO A STRANGER?"

Sadly, it's possible in any church for a visitor to leave without having been engaged in conversation by someone. One reason is that most of us are basically shy and don't feel comfortable making the first move. Another reason is that many people don't know what to say. Here are some practical suggestions:

- 1) Introduce yourself and say, "I don't believe we've met, have we?" This goes a long way toward solving the problem of greeting an unrecognized fellow member, and also provides direction for the conversation.
- 2) If you know they're visiting, ask "What brings you to our church today?" This may provide information on how our church or pastor may provide some ministry to that

person.

- 3) At some point in the conversation, you might state in one sentence what you appreciate most about your congregation, such as: "I love this church because..."
- 4) Introduce the visitor(s) to someone else, if it can be done graciously.
- 5) Don't forget to invite the visitor to return!

If our congregation is going to be welcoming and warm toward everyone (as Janise and I have found in our 7+ months here!), then we all have to do it! I know it may be hard for some of you to walk up to a stranger and begin a conversation, especially in a close-knit, family-tied faith family like St. John's. But hopefully these suggestions will help. So try – take the risk. You may find a new friend! Since we have several new members who will be joining, use that opportunity. Start now in your welcoming habit! Don't leave it just to the pastor or the deacons on duty. Have faith that your greeting, your warm smile, your inviting spirit will make a difference!




