MARION TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO.1993-29

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MARION ESTABLISHING REQUIREMENTS FOR MUD-FREE THOROUGHFARES.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARION TOWNSHIP TO ESTABLISH AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING MUD-FREE THOROUGHFARES.

SECTION I. It should be unlawful for anyone, either intentionally or unintentionally, to deposit or otherwise allow to be deposited mud, dirt or other debris on public thoroughfares within the municipality. In the case of new construction, the property owner shall be obligated to ensure the installation of a mud-free (gravel or paved) driveway extending from the cartway the greater of 50 feet or to the property setback line contemporaneously with the initiation of any construction activity.

SECTION II. PENALTIES. Violators of this ordinance shall be responsible to pay all clean-up costs and subject to fines of up to \$300.00 per day with each day constituting a separate violation.

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such finding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such part not been included.
