In September, RBDigital merged into Overdrive. For our RBDigital users, that means that you will need to download app to continue listening to downloadable audiobooks, but now you'll have many more options! If you already have the Overdrive app, that will work, too!

All you need is your Wilson Public Library card and the pin number (call us at 784-2019 for that info!). Libby and Overdrive are available 24/7/365 with a WIFI connection and your books are available offline once downloaded. There are never fines. Never be caught without a book again!

Currently, there are over 150 magazines available for immediate download via RBDigital (formerly known as Zinio), our downloadable magazine stash. Again, this will change with Overdrive's acquisition, but we'll keep you up to date on

Sculptures purchased and dedicated to the library in 2017 in honor of our 100th anniversary as a Carnegie library were moved to a pedestal in the Art Garden in the first phase. The second phase sculpture has also been purchased and is simply waiting for its base to be poured. The landscaping in both first and second phases has been completed.

To help offset the final phases, the Cozad Library Foundation is again selling engraved bricks to outline the paved area slated for phase 4 of the garden. Each personalized brick (up to 3 lines) costs \$100. The next batch of bricks will be ordered on December 2. All bricks purchased will be displayed until the next phase begins. Things to Remember As You Visit the Library

- Check in with staff and use our hand sanitizer.
- Practice social distancing while in the library.
- Wearing a mask is highly encouraged for patrons and required for patrons with a public computer appointment.
- Call us at 784-2019 for a computer appointment before entering the library for that day. Appointments are required for those who need public computer access, are limited per day and are for 30 minutes. Headphones are not available at this time.
- Masks are required for those using the computer lab.
- Wifi is available without an appointment
- Guests 8 and older are welcome: adults with children under 8 must use the library together.
- Visits for library use other than public computers are limited to once per day, for up to one hour.
- In-person indoor programming will slowly be added back to the library but may require registration.
- Public Restrooms & Public Phones are sanitized once per day; use at own risk. The library also limits what is sanitized daily; use at own risk.
- Library materials are guarantined upon return and may not be immediately available to check out.
- Until further notice, no toys or computers are available in the chil-

The Wilson Public Library reserves the right to modify these restrictions based on Health Care Directives from Two Rivers District Health Department and/or City of Cozad Administration. You are using the library at your own risk. The Wilson Public Library and the City of Cozad are not responsible if you contract the Coronavirus. 

A reminder that there is NO Storytime on Friday, November 27, due to Thanksgiving!






Harry Potter House Cup Ceremony
