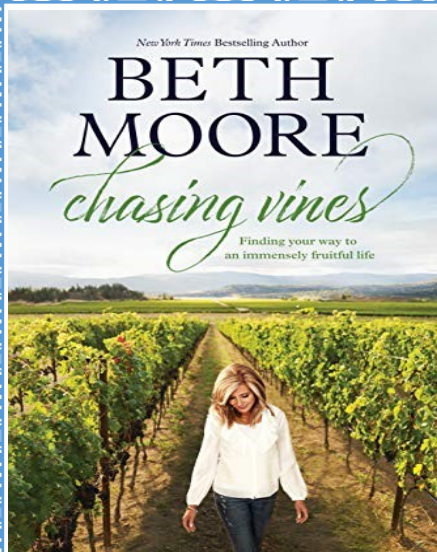

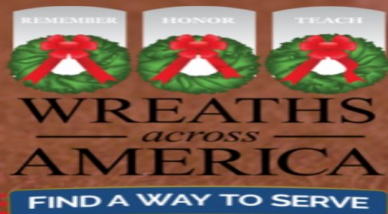

During the week, they pressure washed the house and porches, painted most of the house, removed rotten fascia and gutters, painted the porches, replaced fascia and gutters, removed and replaced a storm door. The homeowner, Irene Smallwood, was surprised to see five women on her doorstep. As the week progressed, she began to look forward to their return.

The temperature was a bit chilly each morning until the sun rose over the mountain. Each evening, the group shared devotions and discussed the day. God blessed the group in many ways during the week.

Bellevue Area Social Services is an inter-denominational organization that works to help the homeless and needy in our area. The anchors are Shepherds Lighthouse and St. Theresa Catholic Church. Other members are Bellevue United Methodist, Seven Day Adventist, Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints, First Baptist, St. Mary's Episcopal, Destiny Church, Representative Daniel Webster's office and others. There are special presentations from other groups at our meetings. Recently, Interfaith Services shared what they do. We share needs and resources to help each other. Shepherds Lighthouse focuses on transitional housing and helping those in human trafficking escape. St. Theresa provides items to the homeless, including plastic ground mats made by BUMC and other churches. They have a soup kitchen, food pantry and

referral services. Current plans include the spring give away event. The items needed include bug spray, umbrellas, cleaning supplies, aluminum foil, diapers, and plastic wrap. An immediate need is hats, coats, socks, gloves, especially for children. Items can be donated anytime. Contact JoAnn Benton directly or bring to the church office for pick up. Sharon Leino and Terri Silvola-Finch are also representatives from BUMC to BASS.

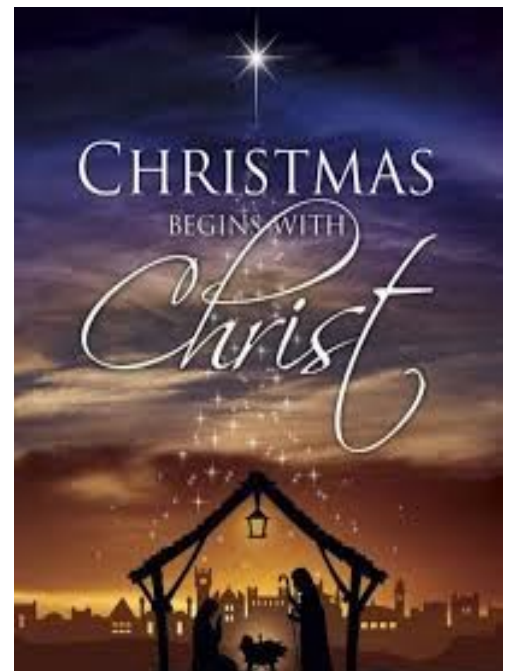


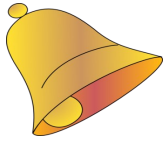
