

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 26 ,1996
MEETING CONVENED AT 8:30 PM. COMMANDER TONY CIOTOLA
PRESIDING. 36 MEMBERS WERE PRESENT.
ROLL CALL OF OFFICERS.

NEW MEMBERS INTRODUCED WERE JOE LUISI AND BRUNO CHIAPPI.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

MEMBERSHIP - DENIS CONROY MADE HIS FIRST REPORT. THE POST HAS 128 MEMBERS PAID TO DATE AND THAT INCLUDES SIX NEW MEMBERS.

PUBLICITY-LESTER MODULIWITZ REPORTED THAT HE HAD DIFFICULTY GETTING THE INSTALLATION ANNOUNCEMENT IN THE SI ADVANCE. HE FINALLY GOT IT IN A COUPLE OF DAYS LATE.

HONOR GUARD-RICHIE REICHARD ANNOUNCE THAT WE HAVE 3 NEW MEMBERS IN THE HONOR GUARD. THE HONOR GUARD WILL HAVE THE WORDS "COUNTY HONOR GUARD" IN WHITE ADDED TO THEIR HATS AND THE COST WILL BE PAID BY THE COUNTY.
