Below is a list of items to help you put together your kit.

Prescriptions (2-week supply)

Medications/Over-the-counter

Water (3-day supply, 1-2 gallons per person per day)

Non-perishable food (3-day supply)

Generator

Fill up with Gas

Get Cash

Valuables (papers (SS card, credit card, legal papers, jewelry)

Radio (Battery-powered or hand crank radio and a NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert)

Lights

Batteries

Phone chargers –battery powered

Candles/lighters

Baby food/clothing/medication (if applicable)

Pets/pet food

Photos

Travel size toiletries

First Aid Kit

Whistle with neck cord

Change of clothes

Pocket Knife

Dust Mask

Local Maps

Can Opener

Wipes

Fire extinguisher
