##### MISC:

1. **Proper regulation hair/haircuts**, shave, and boots blackened/shined are required.
2. If you need to be dismissed early, arrive late, or are going to be absent, pass it up the chain of command. Contact your LPO and report on the unit website (Members page).
3. **Bring your hydration**, sunscreen, and Local Orders. You will not receive community service credit without orders.
4. Enter Ivy Lawn main gate, and follow the road to about the middle of the cemetery, staying to the right. You will see other cadets forming up. Submit your orders and report to the LPO.
5. Make sure you EAT BREAKFAST before arriving.
6. Parents are welcome to stay and take photos. We have dismissed early at other times that we have done this detail, and our dismissal time is an estimated time.
