

New Vienna City Council Meeting
April 4, 2017

Mayor Pat Hermsen opened the Public Hearing at 5:30pm. Present were council members: Diane Knepper, Jim Naber, and Ken Meyer, Roger Langel, Mike Leuchs at 5:50pm.

Meyer made the motion to approve the agenda for April 4, 2017 seconded by Langel.

Naber made the motion to approve the consent agenda, bills, receipts, financial reports, Seconded by Meyer.

Lucas Elsbernd was present from Fehr Graham to go over the Iowa and Church Street project. The notice for a public hearing will be going out and the Public hearing is set for May 2, 2017 at 6:00pm. The bids will be opened on May 1st at 2:00pm. In the City Hall in New Vienna. Meyer made the motion to approve the additional expense of \$1590.00 for the storm sewer easement, second by Langel. Ayes-all.

Liquor license for New Vienna Athletic Association was approved on a motion from Meyer, seconded by Naber. Ayes-all.

The disinfection system is up and running, Mike Neuhaus stated that the City had caught a water leak for a resident after we read the meters; the toilet was running and had gone through 50,000 gallons of water.

The Fire Station project was reviewed, Roger Langel stated that he had been meeting with J&L Lumber to try and get an idea for the size of building we would need for the fire department. Fire Chief was present as well as fireman to voice their opinions and concerns for this new structure. Roger will head this committee to work on the plans.

Building Permit for Mike Neuhaus to put up a permanent canopy over his deck was approved on a motion from Meyer, second by Leuchs. Ayes-all. Building permit for new home construction for Amanda Kluesner was approved on a motion from Naber, second by Leuchs. Ayes-all.

Bob McCabe present to voice his concern with the water pressure and what the city is going to do about it. The Mayor informed Bob that we are looking into this and are trying to find a great solution for the city. The City is still looking at options and cost.

Diane Knepper reported that the NV business Boosters will no longer be doing the picnic in the park, they are looking at putting dues towards betterment of the city and beautification.

Mike Neuhaus informed council that he is looking at a new timer for the noon whistle as it has not been working lately. The Warning siren will be getting a battery maintainer put on it to help with its operating. Mike will also contact Jeff Willenborg for the tree trimming in the park.

The City received notification that the families of Leo & Sue Goedken would like to donate two benches to the city in their memory. The Council discussed options for placement of these.

WMT tractorcade will be coming to New Vienna June 12th, 13th this year.

There being no further business to discuss the meeting was adjourned on a motion from Meyer, second by Knepper at 6:50pm.
