News Around the Community

There's a lot of activity and updates around the community, so here is a list of some of the key things discussed at the recent HOA meeting in August:

- Several traffic studies were recently done in an effort to try to get drivers
 to slow down and observe stop signs, particularly on Woodgrove Way and
 Greyhawk Drive. The most effective method was observed to be the
 "speed radar" signs, which did appear to slow more people down. The
 board is soliciting pricing with an intent to install signs near both the
 Douglas Blvd. and Eureka Road entries to the community.
- Construction on the Eureka Grove community (corner of Sierra College and Eureka) is progressing, and it appears that a walkway is planned from that community to Greyhawk Drive, not far from its junction with Streamside Court. The tract of land including the walkway is owned by Eureka Grove rather than Greyhawk, so we can't affect its completion. However, use of private Greyhawk property (such as the community park) is limited to Greyhawk residents.
- To deter non-residents from using the park, the board is considering adding more signs, and modifying the current wood post-and-wire "fencing" along the street side, to potentially be more of a deterrent and less subject to weather damage. If you have a specific idea, please submit it to a board member or e-mail it to Jennifer (contact above and to the left). In the interim, the 2 fence posts which need replacement are being replaced (this may be completed before this edition of the newsletter reaches you).

Tips and Neighborhood Notes

Some ideas for our homes and yards:

- Lawn and garden tips: many folks are experience an outbreak of nutsedge in their lawn. It's a tall and thin, "V-shaped" sprig that grows quickly in heavily-watered areas and can spread precipitously; there are herbicides available which you can spray directly on the plants to kill them, which is recommended rather than pulling them.
- Winter and the wet weather that typically comes with it will be here before you know it. (Yep, that's hard to believe.) In preparation for it, take some time to check and potentially clean your gutters and drains to make sure they're clear..... and you'll want to do so again after more leaves have fallen.
- With daylight hours now shortening, don't forget to adjust the "on / off" times for your landscape lighting. And don't forget to move your clocks and all timers back an hour when Daylight Saving Time ends on November 7th!
