Committee Updates

Policy Seminar Updates

Records were set as 72 Republicans were among a record 248 U.S. Representatives who publicly signed onto the <u>House TRIO letter</u> requesting a "robust increase" in FY22 funding. Co-led by Representatives Gwen Moore (D-WI), Christopher Smith (R-NJ), Donald Payne, Jr. (D-NJ), and Vicky Hartzler (R-MO).

Government Relations Updates

- Biden-Harris Administration released its first budget request to Congress for Fiscal Year 2022, which included:
 - \$200 million (or 18%) funding increase for TRIO, for a total proposed appropriation of \$1.3 billion.
 - \$40 million (or 11%) funding increase for GEAR UP, for a total proposed appropriation of \$408 million.
- President Biden proposed additional education investments in the American Families Plan, which includes:
 - Increase of max Pell Grants by \$1,400
 - New college completion state grant program for low-income students
 - Tuition free community college



- Two free years of tuition for students who attend HBCU's, Minority-Serving Institutions, and Tribally Controlled Colleges and Universities
- Teacher training
- Universal Pre-K for all 3&4 year olds
- Child care
- Expanding of school-based meal programs
- Education Secretary Miguel Cardona and top Republican Representative Tom Cole praise TRIO at education budget hearing
 - "When you've got something that works, and it's worked for 50 years ... TRIO produced 5 million college graduates in this country. I wonder how many of those kids that went through TRIO would have graduated from college absent that program, or would have even been there in the first place. And I'd say that's a good program."
- Department of Education Updates
 - \circ $\,$ Gear UP state and partnership grants competition have been published
 - Proposals are due Monday June 28th
