Titling info: This Christian Science Church tithes 10% of our collection each month to a specific local, national, or global organizations whose mission we support. Our **May** titling recipient is **Schools of the Heart**, a school in the Democratic Republic of the Congo, run by a Christian Scientist. Currently the school is serving 140 lower income and homeless street children from the area: 15 in pre-school, 70 in regular grades and 55 students in the remedial program. They also reach out to an orphanage about 2 hours outside of town and there they have 30 students they are teaching basic reading and writing to prepare to go to school. When they are ready, then Schools of the Heart pays for them to go to the public school (there is no free education in the DRC). Your prayers are needed to support the concept of education in the region and help heal the civil unrest that threatens the area and leaves the area without electricity frequently invoking more crime.
