***Sewer Service Agreement***

This agreement is entered into by Applicant and the City of Hardin (the "City") for the purpose of establishing and maintaining sewer service at the Service Address. In exchange for the mutual promises herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

**City:**

City agrees to provide sewer service to the Service Address for so long as the Customer pays his/her monthly service bill and abides by all other City ordinances and regulations regarding sewer service.

**Customer:**

Customer agrees to pay his/her monthly service bill and abide by all other City ordinances and regulations regarding the provision of sewer services.

The customer expressly agrees and authorizes the City to enter upon Customer's property for the sole purpose of taking water meter readings with which to determine Customer's monthly bill for sewer service. Please realize the water meter readings from the Water Supply Corporation and City of Hardin will be different.

By executing this agreement, Customer expressly agrees and understands that the failure of the Customer to comply with any part of this agreement or any City ordinance or regulation regarding sewer service may be in violation of provision of Section 29 of Sewer Ordinance and may be fined as provided in Section 58 of the article.

**A copy of the entire sewer ordinance is on file at the City Hall office. The following are some highlights.**

- 1. All work (installation, alterations, repairs, etc.) on sewer lines must be performed by a State of Texas licensed plumber according to the “International Plumbing Code, 2000 Edition”.**
- 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit by any means into the building drainage system or sewer any ashes; cinder; rags; inflammable; poisonous, or explosive liquids; gases; oils; grease; any material which would or could obstruct, damage or overload such system or sewer.**
- 3. No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any storm water, ground water, roof runoff, subsurface drainage, downspouts, yard fountains and ponds or lawn sprays into any sanitary sewer.**
- 4. It shall be unlawful for any person to remove any sewer tap that has been placed by the city, or to in any manner damage, change, or interfere with or tamper with any sewer tap.**
- 5. No person shall injure, break or remove any section of any manhole, lamp hole, flush tank, catch basin or any part of the sewer system of the city or throw or deposit or cause to be deposited or thrown in any sewer openings or receptacles connecting with the sewer system, any garbage, offal, dead animals, vegetables, paring, ashes, cinder, rags, or other matter or things whatsoever, except feces, urine, and the necessary toilet paper, liquid, house or mill slops. The use of a disposal properly connected with a kitchen sink, which installation has been approved by city inspection, is excepted from the provisions herein.**
- 6. No unauthorized person shall maliciously, willfully, or negligently break, damage, or uncover, deface, or tamper with any structure, appurtenances or equipment which is part of the municipal sewage works.**

# NOTICE

## Request for Confidentiality of Personal Information Maintained by the City of Hardin Utilities Department

Personal information in your City of Hardin Utilities Department customer account records (e.g., your address and telephone number) is generally considered public information under the Texas Government Code, Chapter 552 (Public Information Act). The social security number of a living person is confidential and may not be released in most cases.

The Texas Utilities Code, Chapter 182 (Rights of Utilities Customers), provides that a government-operated utility may not disclose personal information if the customer requests that the government-operated utility keep the personal information confidential.

\* A request for confidentiality under Chapter 182 does not prohibit a government-operated utility from disclosing personal information in a customer's account record to: (1) an official or employee of the state, a political subdivision of the state, or the United States acting in an official capacity; (2) an employee of a utility acting in connection with the employee's duties; (3) a consumer reporting agency; (4) a contractor or subcontractor approved by and providing services to the utility, the state, a political subdivision of the state, or the United States; (5) a person for whom the customer has contractually waived confidentiality for personal information; or (6) another entity that provides water, wastewater, sewer, gas, garbage, electricity, or drainage service for compensation. A customer may rescind a request for confidentiality by providing the government-operated utility written permission to disclose personal information. A government-operated utility or an officer or employee of a government-operated utility is immune from civil liability for a violation of Texas Utilities Code, Subchapter B.

This form enables you to request confidentiality of your personal information under Texas Utilities Code, Chapter 182. If you wish to request confidentiality of your personal information, please check the box below and return this form with your payment (*or in the separate envelope provided for that purpose*).

I request that my personal information maintained by the City of Hardin Utilities Department be kept confidential under Texas Utilities Code, Chapter 182. I understand that the City of Hardin Utilities Department may charge each customer who requests confidentiality under this subchapter a fee not to exceed the administrative cost of complying with the request of confidentiality. The fee charged by the City of Hardin Utilities Department for this service is \$0.00.
