

Waldo Cabbage Patch Cemetery

Yuba County

Cabbage Patch was a small community near the stage stop of Spenceville. When Cabbage Patch was to receive a Post Office, it took the more dignified name of Waldo. The Cemetery reportedly had about 20 graves until the property was taken over for Camp Beale during World War II times. The markers were removed and flat concrete slabs were placed over the graves, but only three graves were identified on the slabs.

Follow Smartsville Road from Highway 20 toward the Grass Valley Gate of Beale FB. Turn left about 5.4 miles after leaving Highway 20 onto Waldo Road (gravel in 1986).

Follow this road until you cross an old iron bridge. The cemetery is a short distance past the bridge on the left side of the road.
