5. Then there will be the Dick Baker Memorial Fishing Derby on September the 14. More later on this event.

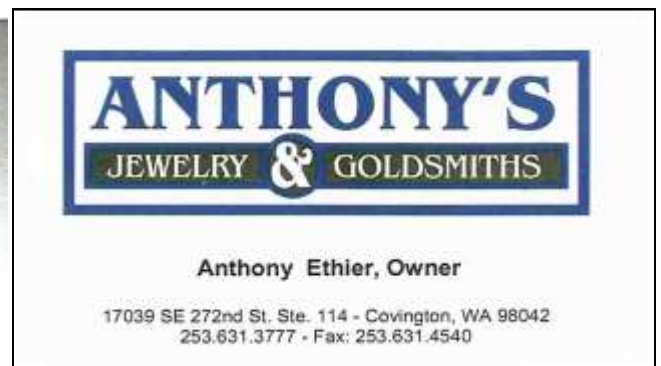
I hope everyone has a super summer cruising, I know Mary and I will. Hope to see you on the water.

### WSYC SUMMER CRUISE CALENDAR

#### JULY

##### 4th of July on Lake Union:

If you'd like to bring your boat, keep in mind there is now a 3 boat raft maximum on Lake Union, also there is room on board the Spring Tides.
