Member Verna Quaranto's mother, Velma Forsyth, passed away on June 21, 2023. She was born in Springfield Missouri on 8/2/1930. Married to Carl Bernard Forsyth in 1946, they had four daughters, Verna Forsyth Quaranto, Gracie Forsyth Martinez, Robin Forsyth Stewart and Koprecia Forsyth.

During this partnership Velma and Carl taught roller skating in various states for 48 years, producing over 31 national champions in various aspects of the sport. Velma and Carl were part of the founding fathers of the industry being involved in every aspect of the sport with students and friends whom they and inspired to expand the excellence of roller skating. In 1999 Mrs. Forsyth and her husband were inducted into the USA Roller Skating Hall of Fame for their distinguished service and promotion of the sport. In 1959 they moved to San Antonio, eventually building seven rinks here and were partners for one in Colorado Springs.

Verna and her sisters eventually purchased the family business, allowing Velma and Carl to retire to a life of travel and enjoying a new sport of ball room dancing!

A memorial service will be held August 9 at 1:30 at University Methodist Church, corner of DeZavala and Vance Jackson. Reception at 3PM at Tomatillos Restaurant at 1604 & 281.

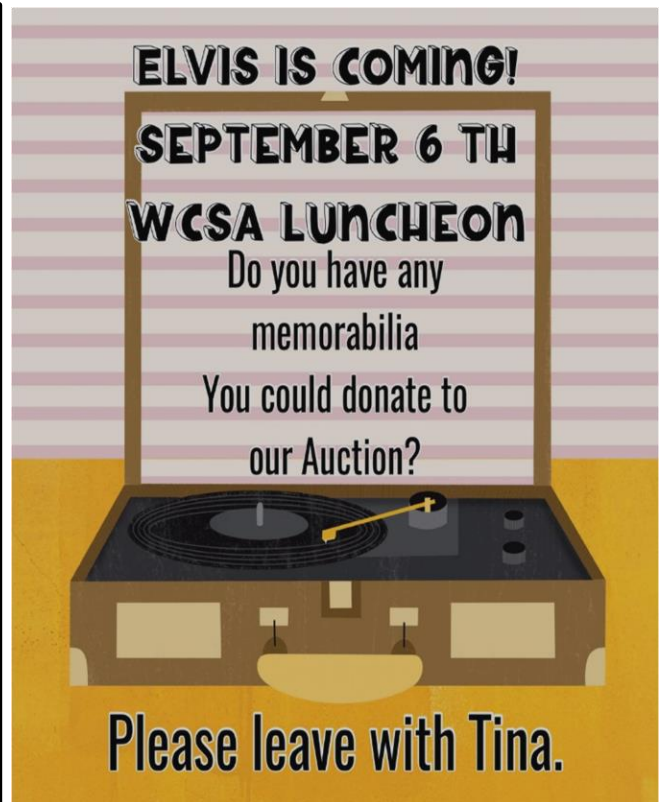

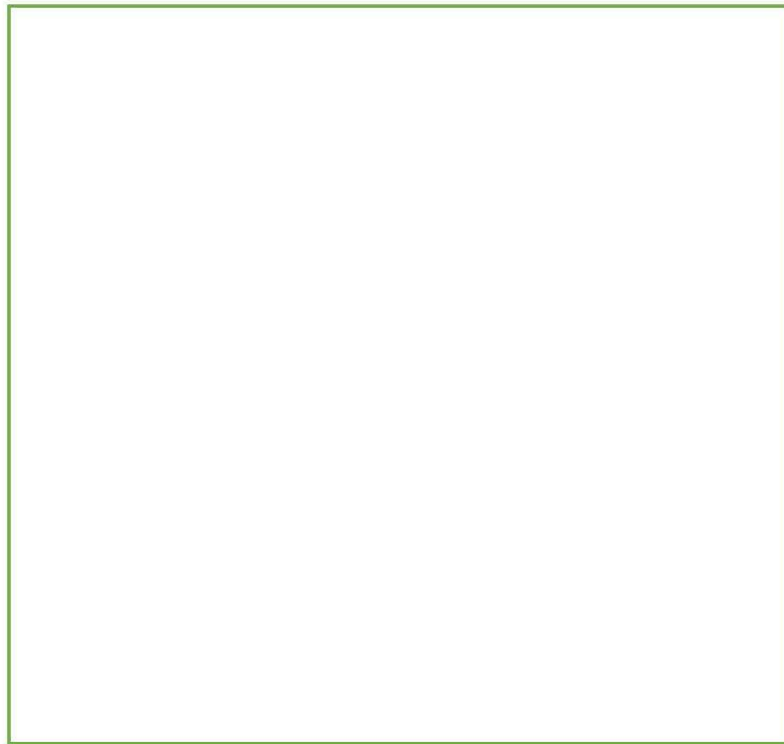
