

Backing: white on white

3" X WOF subcut 3" square (12) 6

4 ½ X WOF strips subcut rectangles 4 ½ X 2 ½ (4)

4 ½ x 4 ½ subcut square diagonally one to make half-square triangles (2)

Fabrics 1

4 1/2 X 4 1/2 square (1)

Fabrics 2

5 ½ X 5 ½ square subcut diagonal once make (B) half-square Triangles

Fabrics 3

3 x 3 square (12) 6

Cornerstone:


1 1/2 x WOF 6 inches

(2) Diamond in a square units 3 ½ X 3 ½ square

## MAKING THE PIECED BLOCKS


**DESIGNER'S NOTE:** The block center portion is an 8" finished Economy block. Quilters may choose to make this unit using foundation paper piecing. A full-sized foundation piecing template is available for free download from ivoryspring.wordpress.com.

Step 1 Sew (1) Background "A" Half-Square triangle to both sets of opposite sides of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric 1 square.




Step 2 Trim around Step 1 unit to include 1/4" seam allowance at points of center square.

Trim unit to measure 6-1/8" x 6-1/8" unfinished (mathematically correct). Quilters are encouraged to make a test unit.



Step 3 Sew (1) Fabric 2 "B" Half-Square triangle to both sets of opposite sides of trimmed Step 1 unit. Trim unit 1/4" away from triangle points.

Unit to measure 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished.




Step 4 Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" Background square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 3" Fabric 3 square.

Sew 1/4" away from both sides of drawn line.
Cut along drawn line to make (2) HST units.
Open and press. Align diagonal seams of HST


units on 45° line on quilting ruler. **Trim units to** measure 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" unfinished. Make a total of (12) HST units.



Step 5 Noting orientation, sew (1) Step 4 HST unit to the opposite short sides of (1) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Background rectangle to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units and sew to the opposite sides of Step 3 unit.




Step 6 Sew (2) Step 4 HST units to each short side of (1) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Background rectangle to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units and sew to the opposite sides of Step 5 unit to complete (1) pieced block. Block will measure 12-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished. Make a total of (5) blocks from each of the (6) fabric sets for a total of (30) blocks.



## MAKING THE CORNERSTONES

Sew together (5) 1-1/2" Print squares and (4) 1-1/2" Background squares to make (1) Cornerstone unit. **Unit will measure 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" unfinished.** Make a total of (20) units.



## MAKING THE DIAMOND-IN-A-SQUARE UNITS

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2" Background square. Place square, right sides together, on a corner of (1) 3-1/2" square cut from leftover Fabrics 1-3. Sew on drawn line and trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Repeat with (3) additional 2" Background squares on the remaining corners of the same 3-1/2" square to complete unit. Make a total of (110) units.
