DESCRIPTION: The iconic Necedah is one of the great all-purpose bows of all time. This bow has a few minor issues but is still an exceptional shooter. There is a 1" hairline superficial crack in the middle of the grip (see pic on p. 5). Bow also had some minor delamination repair (see last pic); this was done by a previous owner who may have failed to clamp it properly. I put this bow to a stress test (held at full draw for 18 hours) to make sure there was no failure. Bow has no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are in good shape. I recently shot this bow and it performed very well, like most Shakespeare bows do.
