President's Message

Congratulations Joe Hederman on your Hole-in-one, 14 hole-in-ones REALLY! Don't wait 19 years for # 15.

I have been told that some of our members have been inconsiderate towards other golfers while playing in a skins game or in our tournaments. With this said please read the following excerpts from the SCGA regarding this subject:

Unlike many sports, golf is played, for the most part, without the supervision of a referee or umpire. The game relies on the integrity of the individual to show consideration for other players and abide by the rules. All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be.

This is the spirit of the game of golf.

No Disturbance or Distraction

Players should always show consideration for other players on the course and should not disturb their play by moving, talking or making any unnecessary noise.

Don't drive up to other golfers when they are setting up or in the process of hitting their shot.

Players should ensure that any electronic device taken onto the course does not distract other players.

On the teeing ground, a player should not tee his ball until it is his turn to play. Players should not stand close to or directly behind the ball, or directly behind the hole, when a player is about to play.

On the putting green, players should not stand on another player's line of putt or when he is making a stroke, cast a shadow over his line of putt. Players should remain on or close to the putting green until all other players in the group have holed out.

Bunkers

Before leaving a bunker, players should carefully fill up and smooth over all holes and footprints made by them and any nearby made by others.

Repair of Divots, Ball-Marks and damage by shoes

Players should carefully repair any divot holes made by them and any damage to the putting green made by the impact of the ball (whether or not made by the player himself).
