A. Set Public Hearing for Budget Date for Budget Hearing for February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2015 at 7:15 p.m.:

**MOTION** by Quail, supported by Nash, to set the Budget Hearing to be held on February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2015 at 7:15 p.m. Council voiced all ayes

#### **B.** 2015/2016 Budget Workshop:

Council reviewed the attached proposed profit & loss budget overview for Each fund that is dated January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2015 for the period of March 2015 Through February 2016. Council agreed to make the following revisions to the proposed budget for the budget hearing:

Revise Treasurer Salary currently reflected as a total amount of \$35,800.00 between the Funds as follows:

101-253-702 - Treasurer Salary - \$24,000.00

101-244-285 - DDA Administration Wages - \$1,800.00

591-521-702 - Water Fund Administration Salaries - \$5,000.00

590-521-702 – Sewer Fund Administration Salaries - \$5,000.00

To reflect 28 hours at \$17.97 per hour for a total annual salary of \$26,164.32 split between the General Fund, DDA Fund, Water and Sewer Funds.

- Remove 5,000 for Capital Outlay under Halls and Grounds 101-265-970
- Remove \$4,500.00 for Contract Mowing under DPW 101-441-805
- ➤ Remove \$750.00 for Blight Contracting under DPW 101-441-806.
- ➤ No changes were made to the water/sewer rates.

Council discussed the following budget proposals for village employees in the following departments:

#### **Administration:**

Administrative wage increases of 2% for the Clerk and Treasurer.

## **Department of Public Works:**

- ➤ DPW Employees James Heacock and Kermit Woidan will receive a \$1.00 increase with each water and sewer certification obtained but not for the chemical certification which is required under the water certification.
- ➤ DPW Equipment Purchases that will be approved and reflected in the budget are as follows:

Back Hoe Forks -	\$ 1,625.00

2015 Ford F2500 (Fleet Purchase) Total Cost -	\$34,414.92

➤ Council agreed that more research needs to be done regarding OSHA regulations before making a purchase of a Sky Lift.
