We ordered food off the Hops House menu and Pres. Ken found eating his chicken wings a little challenging with his long flowing Blonde locks in his face!

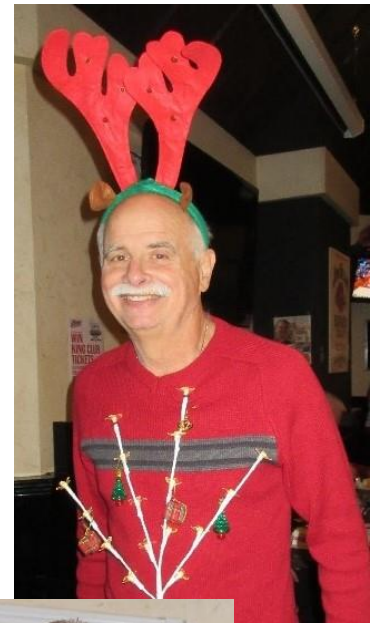
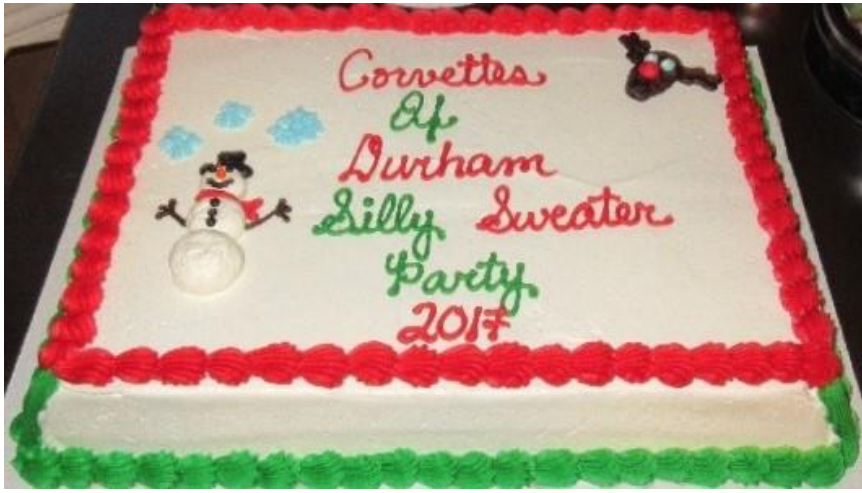
