

Did you not file taxes?

Congress passed a law calling for cash payments to most households in the U.S., people with low incomes haven't had a simple way to deal with the requirement that they file a tax return to get the benefit.

The Internal Revenue Service unveiled a new website, Friday, where people who don't normally file tax returns can enter bank account information so they can receive coronavirus payments.

The new site is on www.irs.gov. There's a big blue button that says "Non Filers: Enter Payment Info Here."
