



The Last Rites are (ideally*) three Sacraments: the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, the Sacrament of Confession, and the Eucharist. These should be given if an individual is gravely ill or near death (this sacrament is also given to people before major surgery or other serious health issues that are not emergencies).




