TUITION

SUPPLEMENTAL TUITION OBLIGATION (PER FAMILY)

Each family is required to raise \$350 in profits from sales/purchases –OR– \$350 Buyout (per family)

\$350 Buyout: Pay in full at registration –OR– add to tuition payments through FACTS.

Events subject to change: SCRIP; Gift Wrap; Cookie Dough; Candy; and Additional Raffle Tickets.

Unfulfilled balance will be billed in May.

Additional funds raised (over \$350 in profits) may be credited to the next school year’s tuition.

Families who leave the school will donate all earned credit to the school’s general fund.

2016-17 SERVICE HOUR OBLIGATIONS

FAMILIES WITH A NEWLY ENROLLED STUDENT

MUST work Bingo one Friday evening per month from July to June (12 nights). MANDATORY – NO BUYOUT.

Families who register in July, August or September are required to serve until they complete 12 nights.

\$100 non-compliance fee will be assessed for missed night; failure to sign in; arriving late/leaving early (each occurrence).

Bingo fulfills your service hour obligation.

FAMILIES WITHOUT A NEWLY ENROLLED STUDENT. MUST FULFILL BOTH A AND B

A. MUST work a minimum of 1 bingo night per year. MANDATORY – NO BUYOUT.

Sign ups are first come, first served.

\$100 non-compliance fee will be assessed for missed night; failure to sign in; arriving late/leaving early (each occurrence).

B. AND choose option 1, 2 or 3 below:

1. Serve an additional 11 bingo nights to complete your service hour obligation – total of 12 nights.
\$100 non-compliance fee will be assessed for missed night; failure to sign in; arriving late/leaving early (each occurrence).
2. Serve an additional 25 hours in another capacity – must also serve 1 bingo night.
Unfulfilled service hours will be billed at \$10 per hour in May.
Sign-up for service hours at registration or watch the Tuesday Memo for opportunities.
Families serving other than bingo must turn in monthly service hour forms to receive service hour credit.
Must be VIRTUS trained and fingerprinted if volunteering when children are present.
3. \$250 service hour buyout – must also serve 1 bingo night.
Buyout can be paid at registration –OR– added to tuition payments through FACTS.
Unfulfilled service hours will be billed at \$10 per hour in May.

TO AVOID A \$100 BINGO NON-COMPLIANCE FEE, YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE TO

arrive on time and stay duration of shift.

sign “in” and “out”.

swap days with another bingo worker –OR– find a substitute if you are unable to work. Must be 18 years of age or older.

contact bingo manager for schedule changes. Do NOT call the rectory or school office regarding substitutions.
