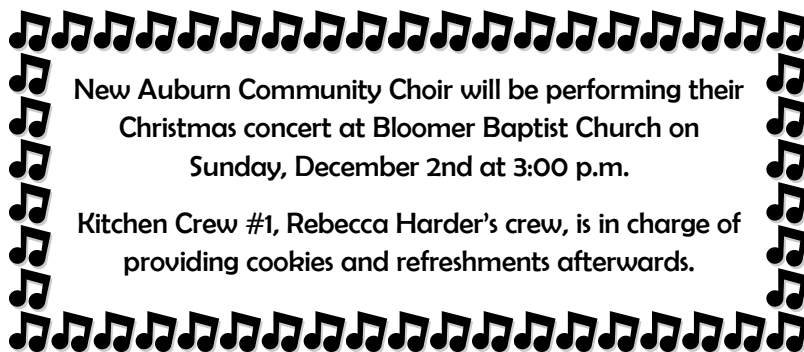
Join us at the annual Bloomer
