During this Christmas season I want to challenge all of you to be more diligent in studying God's word, spending time in prayer and focusing on the season of Advent.

For the next several Sundays we will be considering passages from the book of Psalms. Each week will have a specific theme. In preparation, I encourage you to read the passage listed below once a day for the week prior to the message.

Then, come and discuss with us how God spoke to you during our 8 am Christmas and Cookies class on Sunday mornings and then hear a message during that week's service on the passage.

Here are the passages to read for each week:

For Week 1 (December 3rd) - Psalm 80:1-7, 17-19 For Week 2 (December 10th) - Psalm 85:1-2, 8-13 For Week 3 (December 17th) - Psalm 126 For Week 4 (December 24th) - Psalm 89:1-4, 19-26

While we won't have service on Christmas morning, please read Psalm 96 that day and focus on singing out to God, declaring His glory, and proclaiming that the baby Jesus is KING!
