**REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
MINUTES OF July 11 2017**

Supervisor Hebert called the meeting to order at 7:02 P.M. at the Ganges Township Hall located at the corner of 119th Ave. and 64th St. Board members present by roll call attendance: Reimink, Hebert, Puglise, Gooding and Hutchins.

Reimink moved and Hutchins seconded, to approve the agenda dated July 11, 2017 as presented. Motion carried.

County Commissioner Jessup did not attend.

Correspondence -

Email communications between Hebert, Puglise and Rudy Broekhuis regarding garbage pick-up at Pier Cove appeared to confirm that the problem of early pick-ups has been solved by Republic Service, and pick-up will not, in the future, be made before 6:00 a.m.

Public Comments

Hebert moved, Hutchins seconded, to approve the regular meeting minutes of 06/13/17 as presented, with corrections, motion carried.

Hutchins moved, Reimink seconded to approve the special meeting minutes of 06/29/17 as presented. Motion carried.

Reimink reported the balances as of 05/31/2017 as follows:

Puglise moved, Gooding seconded, to accept the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.

Reimink moved, Hebert seconded payment of the bills as listed with removal of the \$6000.00 payment for dust control by the Road Commission from the General Fund to the Road fund. Motion carried.

COMMITTEE REPORT

Puglise presented 1st Responder's request for a check in the amount of \$1,400.00 to cover Medical First Responder training. Hebert moved, Puglise seconded to approve payment to Wayland EMS for the training. Motion carried.

Gary Holton, Cemetery Sexton reported on the tree removal at Taylor cemetery. Stumps are still to be ground. Holton also advised that the Buoys at Hutchins Lake are not positioned, for lack of a DNR permit.

Barry Gooding reported that the Planning Commission denied Cottage Homes plan, as there was a line dispute in the drawings, and our ordinance does not permit business centers.

Gooding also reported that the Cranes matter was moved to the 8/22/ meeting.

OLD BUSINESS –

Hebert moved, Hutchins seconded placing a lien on the Banazek property for payment of clean-up fees. Motion carried.

Puglise moved, Hebert seconded placing a lien on the Bastow property for payment of clean-up fees. Motion carried.

MTS asked for authority to enforce zoning requirements on Kenneth Craycraft regarding his failure to install a fence and gate. By roll call, aye's Hebert, Hutchins, Reimink, Puglise – Nays – Gooding – 4/1 vote. Motion carried.

Puglise moved, Reimink seconded, to issue an event permit to Crane's. . Motion carried.

Hebert moved, Hutchins seconded support of a Resolution for Allegan County Road Commission to reinstate the 50/50 cost share for culverts.
