

Harold E. Weidman

1924 - 1997

Harold Elmer Weidman, age 73 of Pigeon, passed away Monday, September 1 at Scheurer Hospital in Pigeon following a brief illness.

He was born in McKinley Township on July 24, 1924, the son of the late Moses and Laura (Eichler) Weidman. On August 17, 1946 he was united in marriage to Iva L. Krohn in Pigeon. She preceded him in death on April 26, 1977. On June 3, 1978 he married Ailine A. Krohn Curran at St. John's Lutheran Church, Berne. She survives him.

Mr. Weidman was a Pigeon High School graduate. He farmed throughout his lifetime and was a longtime member of the Berne Farm Bureau. He was a member of the Scenic Golf & Country Club, and from 1978-1994 he was a member of the Pigeon Lions Club.

He was a very active member of St. John's Lutheran Church, Berne.
