

## WHEELCHAIR QUILTS

Approximate finished size 36" x 36"

3 layers: Top

(use a panel if you want, bigger piece of fabric say 20" x 36")

Batting

Flannel for backing (to prevent slipping and for warmth)

Notions: Fabric for tabs

Velcro

Piece the quilt top to size (or use panel and flip and stitch as below)

Cut flannel and batting to about 36 ½ "

Layer batting on wrong side of flannel

Place bigger piece of fabric in center of batting then sew and flip strips of fabric on sides until you reach the edge.

Bind edges

Attach Velcro tabs (about the length of your thumb) to the bottom corners.

Velcro "face up" on one corner, opposite Velcro "face down" on the other corner (this allows fastening at the foot plate of the wheel chair and keeps backs of legs warm). Silke has been told this is needed even the summer due to generally poor circulation.

If you do not want to bother with Velcro, Silke will add it for you.
