




# November Newsletter 2017

**Help your kids help themselves**— With the weather getting colder, we are working with the **children putting on their coats by themselves.**

I know that it is easier to do it for them, but please encourage your children to put their coats on by themselves. Also, if they turned their sleeves inside out when they took their coat off, let them reach in and pull out the sleeve. The more they can do for themselves, the better.

Independence is a large part of what we practice in preschool. Once your child is confident about putting on their coat, begin to teach them how to zip (or button, or snap) it themselves. It is never too early!! Some of the children in the bumble-  
bee class are doing great at zipping.

**It is the process, not the product.** As you see papers and art projects come home, please remember it is the process not the product. We are doing these things for the experience of doing them. When we write lines, paint, draw, cut or glue, we are working on controlling our fingers so that when I am ready, I can write my letters and my name. The important part is not what it looks like when I get finished, the important part is that I tried and I did it!!

**Please make sure you send hats and gloves** with your child every day. Even though it is getting colder, we will still go outside.

### Where is God?

*But He said, "You cannot see My face; for no man shall see Me, and live" (Exodus 33:20)*


We can't see God because He is a spirit-but the Bible says Moses spoke to God face to face! Can we see God like Moses? The Bible tells us He is omnipresent by His Spirit. That means He is everywhere and sees everything all the time. That is very hard to understand, and seems simply amazing, even to me! I get a tiny idea of just how amazing it is when I fly in an airplane. When I go over a big city like New York and look down I see thousands and thousands of lights –cars, houses, building, shopping malls, lots of people down there. I realize that God sees them at soccer, at the mall, in the house, at church, in the park, playing with their friends, He sees EVERYONE and KNOWS what they are doing! He also knows our hearts. He knows what we are thinking. He knows whether we love Him. He knows our needs. He is everywhere, and He knows everything about you. And even though we accept this by faith, it is not a blind faith. You see, what we read in God's Word, which is the primary way God communicates to us today, makes sense of what we see in God's world. Also, in many ways, science confirms God's Word it true. Now God revealed Himself to us in the person of Jesus-when He came to earth as a man. Many eyewitnesses saw Jesus and the miracles he did! Today we "see Him" through the words of the Bible.
