

## Pioneer Resident Taken By Death



### WILLIAM HARVEY

William Harvey, 84, lifelong resident of this vicinity, passed away early Thursday morning following a long illness.

Mr. Harvey was born May 1864 in Chandler Township. April 15, 1891, he was united in marriage with Jessie Alexander Chandler. Mr. and Mrs. Harvey cleared the land which became their farm and resided there until 1921 when they moved to Elkton where Mr. Harvey was janitor of the school until 1932 when they moved back to the farm. In April 1940 they returned to Elkton where he has since resided. They celebrated their golden wedding anniversary April 15, 1941. Mr. Harvey passed away April 11 of this year.

Surviving are one son, Charles Harvey, Chandler Township, one daughter, Mrs. Jessie Rowe, Elkton; one grandson, one granddaughter and one sister, Mrs. Elizabeth Bouck, Elkton.

Funeral services were held Saturday afternoon from the Colonial Funeral Chapel, with Rev. L. Burgess, pastor of the Evangelical United Brethren Church, officiating. Interment was in the Colonial Cemetery, Bad Axe.
