**ORDER REGARDING THE SIXTEENTH APPLICATION FOR FEES
BY THE RECEIVER AND RECEIVER'S COUNSEL**

Came on to be heard the Sixteenth Application of Eduardo S. Espinosa, the receiver for Retirement Value, LLC (the "Receiver"), for fees for himself and his counsel, K&L Gates, LLP and Cox Smith Matthews Incorporated (the "Application") covering the months of December 2012, January 2013 and February 2013.

The Receiver has requested \$45,310.18 in fees to be paid to K&L Gates for e-discovery services and for defense of the employment discrimination claim pending in New Jersey. He has requested \$242,252.79 in fees to be paid to Cox Smith for his services and those of his counsel. Various parties, including third-party defendant licensees objected to the Application. After

hearing the arguments of counsel and reviewing the evidence submitted by the Receiver, the GRANTS the Application as follows:

The Receiver shall pay K&L Gates, LLP, from the funds of the estate, the sum of \$42,591.57 as its fee for the time period covered by the application.

The Receiver shall pay Cox Smith Matthews, Incorporated, from the funds of the estate, the sum of \$227,717.62 as its fee for the time period covered by the application.
