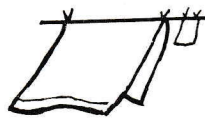
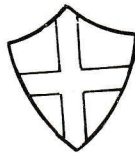
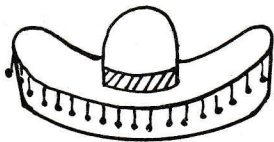
2. He uses a pair of sharp scissors.
