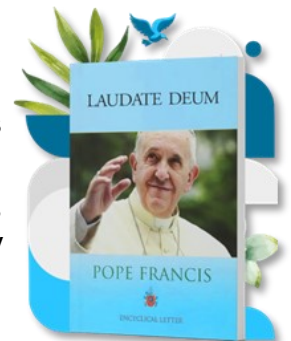
Laudate Deum
