4-H Pullet Chain Showmanship and Interview

1. Judging and interviews will begin at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 7, 2016 in the Livestock Barn at the Orangeburg County Fairgrounds.
2. All participants in the October 7 show should be registered with the show staff starting at 1:30 p.m. on show date.
3. All chickens must be NPIP tested prior to the show.
4. Participants must provide their own coop for the show. Cages will be provided for the show ring only.
5. On show day, the name of each participant will be on a list at the Livestock Gate next to the swine barn. The participant may be accompanied by one adult. Additional passes may be purchased in advance or at the gate.
6. The Orangeburg County Fair manager reserves the right to make decisions concerning changes to rules, regulations, and/or health requirements.
7. Exhibitors and other persons practicing unsportsmanlike behavior or not adhering to the show rules will be asked to leave the show barn; in this case, such exhibitors will be barred from competition and receipt of premiums and/or awards.
8. All decisions made by judges will be final.
9. All flocks will be auctioned following the show.
