Aloha Kakou,

This is it! The month and year that we commemorate and even celebrate the 500th Anniversary of the Reformation! We have all sorts of events scheduled for throughout the month, that are listed elsewhere in this newsletter. I invite you to check them out and heartily encourage you to attend these fine and carefully prepared events.

As you look over these opportunities to worship, reflect and pray with other Protestant, Catholic and Anabaptist Christians, as well as with Jews, Buddhists and Muslims, I invite you to pause and consider what had made the Protestant Reformation what some call the most important religious event of the past one thousand years.

Scholars and pundits will debate this until the end of time, but for us, in Mililani and Central Oahu, at little Christ Lutheran Church, far from Germany and Scandinavia, where the Reformation was born and took early root, I think that the most important takeaway is this: the justified shall live by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone.

When according to folk legend on October 31, 1517 Martin Luther nailed the Ninety Five Theses to the Wittenberg Church door, proposing "academic" discussions for reform of the Roman Catholic Church on the basis of grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone, he kicked off a five-hundred year firestorm of controversy that spilled over from theology to politics, to economics, to the social order. The world hasn't been the same since.

Nowadays, much of what divided that world long ago has been resolved or is being resolved. Indeed, the world itself has changed. There are 3.5 million members of our denomination, the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA); there are 4 million Lutherans in otherwise very Hindu India; there are 5.7 million Lutheran in otherwise very Muslim Indonesia; there are nearly 20 million Lutherans in Ethiopia, Tanzania, and Madagascar combined. There are not so many left in Europe and North America. Lutheranism has shifted south of the equator, to Asia and Africa.

The old cultural Lutheran church is much diminished. Institutions are fading away. So are the old holy wars. But the Lutheran church as *movement*, as a dynamic of the Gospel of grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone, is alive and well. South of the border, you might say and a wee bit above it, in Hawai'i. Thanks be to God for what has come before — and what is coming next.

Priorities remain the same with safety projects accomplished first, followed by gravity projects second. Work from the top down. For instance, replace the roof before painting the exterior of the buildings.

- New, more energy efficient Air Conditioner has been installed in the church front office
- Banyan Tree has been removed
- Purchased a refrigerator for the church kitchen
- Clutter has been hauled away from behind the shed
- New projector purchased

Happening now -

- Waiting for Parking lot lights on order retrofit current & replace.
- Shed door, siding, & back repair scheduled for Oct. 6th
- Roofing: getting specs and bid updates
- Cell Phone Tower analysis and prerequisites in the making

Still needed -

- About \$27,000 more to complete refurbishments and renovations. Stay tuned for the capital campaign, coming in the fall of 2017!
