One of my favorite summer church traditions is Vacation Bible School! When I started my career in ministry I was hired as a Youth Director, but my experience was with Middle School and High School students.

Imagine my shock the first year VBS came around!

My first VBS I was brand new! The church volunteers already had everything ordered, set, planned, and ready to go! All I had to do was show up and be a big ball of energy up front! Easy! What a smack in the face it was a year later when I was "in charge" and now suddenly all these volunteers were looking for me to lead! That first VBS I led left a lot to be desired. So, from that year on I prided myself in making a big deal out of VBS. This area of ministry that once flew under my radar became one of my

favorite things to do! I invited students to come hang out the week before and build sets with me. I found a weird creative outlet in turning piles of paint and cardboard into magical places.

God (and some patient volunteers!) helped me use talents I didn't even know I had, and because of that I've now had a 15-year tradition of crazy, loud, over the top VBS programs and I delight seeing our young students connect with God in this way.

For the second year in a row, Trinity will open its doors to kids from our church and our community ready to see what God will do for five days of VBS! We get to be a part of the faith journey of these children, some who will hear about God's love for the very first time. It's going to be MONUMENTAL. Just like I learned to make a BIG DEAL out of VBS, we'll learn about a Bible character whose dad made a BIG DEAL out of his talents, even if it made his brothers mad! Joseph! We'll begin our journey with Joseph and the dreams God gives him that lead to him being a favorite of his father Jacob, but a target for his 11 brothers. Joseph's story has highs and lows, ups and downs, but in the end, Joseph remains true to the gifts God gave him and finds himself "in charge" when his family needs him most. A weakness in his family turns out to be a strength when Joseph follows God's calling.

Whatever journey God is taking you through, remember He has given you unique gifts to face the challenges ahead! Joshua 1:9 tells us

"For the Lord, your God, is with you wherever you go!"


