Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time
Mark 10:2-16

“Let the children come to me; do not prevent them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these.”

When Jesus was asked a question about the morality and justice of human conduct, He usually quoted the Law of Moses, or asked the questioner “What did Moses command you?” Jesus was aware that people who asked such questions knew the Law, but were either testing His knowledge or looking for a loop-hole. When asked about divorce, Jesus asked “What did Moses say?” The questioner said that Moses permitted a husband to write a bill of divorce. Notice Moses did mention the wife. Jesus acknowledged what Moses allowed because of their “hardness of heart,” but then added, “What God has joined together, no human being must separate.” St. Mark then adds that the disciples were preventing children from reaching Jesus, but He told them to let them come to Him, “For the kingdom of God belongs to such as these.” Jesus is teaching us that marriage is a permanent union of a man and a woman, and the Kingdom of God is for them, and the children that come from such union.
